My Dear Friends in Christ,

With assaults on human life increasing at an alarming rate, I am asking you today to make a personal commitment to pray daily for one unborn child. We, as individuals and as a parish family, have the opportunity to participate in a wonderful program to "spiritually adopt" one unknown baby for the next nine months. Each of us can pray for our child that he or she will be carried to term and experience the fullness of life, as God intended.

For just a moment, picture a young woman who just this week discovered that she is seven weeks pregnant. What she may not know is that her baby's heart has been beating for four weeks, it can flex its fingers and toes, suck on his or her thumb and is totally dependent on her. She may not know where to turn. She may be struggling with her fears of being a mother. She may be experiencing pressure and advice from many caring and well-intentioned family members and friends.

Many people, like us here today, know we all have a strong Father and we care enough to help our brothers and sisters in need. Our prayers can make a difference in whether this baby will be born safely. Our prayers can also be a form of spiritual support for all parents.

Please take a prayer card placed at [\[location\]](#) and pray the very brief prayer daily for your "adopted child". While this child may remain unknown to us, God knows who the child is. Therefore we ask that you name your child in order to stay focused on the reality that your prayers are helping to keep an actual unborn child safe.

At the end of the nine-month period we as a parish will celebrate the "birth" of our spiritually adopted babies with a [\[baby shower/birthday party\]](#) . In this way we can also help, in a very tangible way, the mother as she brings to term a beautiful gift of life. All gifts collected at the shower will be donated to [\[local pregnancy center\]](#) to help mothers in need.

As faithful Catholics we must understand how truly precious the gift of human life is. All too often in our efforts to share this wonderful message we find ourselves in discussions that require an understanding of theology or a knowledge of science or a level of life experience which is exclusive of some members of our faith.

For this reason the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph Office of Life & Justice offers a Spiritual Adoption Program that can be enjoyed by all members of our Catholic family whether in our parishes, in our grade schools, in our middle schools, or in our homes.

There is no cost to participate. Participants in the Spiritual Adoption Program pledge to pray

a brief daily prayer for nine months for an unborn baby. While this child will remain unknown to his or her 'spiritual parent', God knows who the child is. Prayer is the most powerful tool we have.

You will receive monthly updates through [\[method of updates\]](#) describing your baby's development.

At the end of the nine months, our school/parish will hold a baby shower to gather new or gently used items for [\[pregnancy resource center\]](#), a local agency that provides support for mothers in need.

So Spiritual Adoption Program:

- Encourages prayer for parents who are expecting a child; that they will respond to God's grace and welcome their child into life.
- Educates adults and children about the development of the preborn child.
- Provides mothers in need with a 'baby shower' of donated baby gifts.
